COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will give a contemporary glance of digital illustration through blending theory, practice and inspiration. Students will have the chance to understand the digital illustration with its variety of fields of application and its communicative potential.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The aim of the course is to offer a contemporary vision of digital illustration, both from a creative and technical point of view, but also from a practical one. Students will learn the latest trends, several stylistic choices and practical components, applying correctly a sense of observation and criticism.

It will lead students to master a communication language.

The purpose is to reach an artistic vision and also to see the digital illustration application in the path of graphic design, editorial design, advertising, and the increasingly dense world of social networks (especially within the most visual platforms). Students will learn also the basics of *Photoshop* and *Illustrator* practicing with various tools.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

This course is intended for students who have no background in graphic design and who are attending or will attend their first year of university studies in art and design.
